What is the Airport Watch Program?

Airport security is a major concern for aircraft passengers and our tenants.

To ensure the security of passengers and airport property, many Canadian airports have started a Watch Program. The first Canadian program was established back in 1999 by the Ottawa MacDonald-Cartier International Airport. Since then, airports including: Calgary, Vancouver and Halifax have each started their own programs.

In co-ordination with the local RCMP detachment, Canadian Border Service Agency and other agencies, Kelowna International Airport - YLW has started its own program. Airport Watch is designed to involve the community in reporting any suspicious behaviors on YLW property.

We are asking airport tenants and the surrounding community to be an extra set of eyes and ears around the airport and its property.

What to Look For?

- Unusual activity around private aircraft arrivals/ departures
- Unattended Baggage
- Cars parked for long lengths of time in areas surrounding the airport property
- Unlocked gates and or holes in the fence line
- Aircraft with unusual or unauthorized modifications
- Unfamiliar people in restricted areas without a security pass

You are not expected to handle any situation on your own. The three things to remember are;

1. **Observe**
2. **Record**
3. **Report**
